Problem Identified

The Shires Shopping Centre is based in Leicester city centre and consists of 87 stores on two trading levels in a covered shopping environment. However, the service yards and the main entrance to the scheme's 920 car parking spaces are exposed to the elements, meaning they could be vulnerable to icing over in cold weather conditions. The Shires' management team must ensure that staff, the public and all delivery vehicles have safe access at all times.
